#### Location

Bolton Croft is an independent living scheme situated in a lovely area on the outskirts of Leyland. There are 40 self-contained one and two bedroom apartments, each with a lounge, bathroom and kitchen.

Leyland is a thriving Lancashire town with a great sense of community spirit and plenty of amenities. In the local area you will find shops, pubs, cafes, a supermarket, gym and swimming pool as well as various social clubs.

Travel to anywhere in the county and beyond is convenient thanks to the excellent transport network; the cultural hubs of Preston, Manchester and Liverpool are all easily accessible, as is the Lancashire coast and countryside.



### **Services**

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme ranging from bingo and coffee mornings to lunch clubs, music nights and day trips. Residents can also take advantage of the communal computer with internet access or borrow a book from the on-site library. The community centre is easily accessible to everyone and is a great place to grab a cup of tea and have a friendly chat.
