Location

Bridge Court is an independent living scheme in Lostock Hall with 30 one bed self-contained flats and bungalows, each with a lounge, bathroom and separate kitchen.

The quaint village of Lostock Hall offers a good range of local amenities with charming pubs, shops, a library and supermarket right on the doorstep.

The lively City of Preston with its shops, restaurants and historic marina is located only three miles away and with direct buses to Chorley and the surrounding villages; this is the ideal place from which to explore the best that Lancashire has to offer.

About the scheme

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme ranging from bingo and coffee mornings to cabaret evenings and day trips. Residents have access to a computer with internet access and can take advantage of regular visits from the hairdresser and holistic therapist.
